Glasgow Royal Infirmary is the main inpatient hospital for the north and east of the city, providing general hospital services to a core population of 1.2 million and specialist regional services to over half of Scotland. The last decade has seen the opening of two major capital developments – The Princess Royal maternity unit and the Jubilee Building, which accommodates the new A & E department together with the plastic surgery and burns unit and an acute medical receiving unit, plus coronary care and orthopaedic surgery inpatient services.

Within the new A & E department, seating from Knightsbridge Furniture is helping to create an ambience combining style with efficiency. Heading the Knightsbridge line-up is the company's Calm beam seating in a diversity of configurations. To a contemporary upright design based upon a single-piece seat/back, Calm displays smooth lines and graceful curves, with the simple continual sweep from seat to back making it particularly appropriate for environments where infection control is an issue.

In addition to the natural Beech finish supplied to Glasgow Royal Infirmary,

Calm seating is available in a suite of cheerful on-trend shades, including Light Blue, Light Purple, Light Green, Pink, Beige and Yellow.

For younger users of the department, the Knightsbridge order also covered Hokey Cokey twin-seat settees, which are designed to accommodate children aged between two and eight, together with Goldilocks armless stacking chairs in child and adult sizes. All are based on a sturdy hardwood frame and are treated with a durable clear lacquer to maintain the aesthetic appeal of natural wood: Goldilocks chairs have a one-piece seat/back whilst Hokey Cokey features removable and replaceable foam upholstery in a variety of different covers, including breathable, waterproof fabrics resistant to stains and microbial action.
