

## Golden Jubilee National Hospital, Clydebank



Tables and matching seating custom-designed by Knightsbridge have helped create a fresh new look for the restaurant in the Golden Jubilee National Hospital in Clydebank, near Glasgow.

The opening of the refurbished restaurant marked the completion of an extensive redevelopment programme which embraced all catering services within the hospital. The servery and dining areas were completely re-designed, with the new layout promising to minimise queues and yet still be able to seat up to 312 diners in comfort – 100 more than had previously been the case.

Included in the furniture specified for the project were 88 dining tables created by Knightsbridge designers in line with the original architectural drawings. Now named 'Porto' and forming part of the Knightsbridge Healthcare Collection, the tables feature a smart white laminate top with a contrasting rounded edge, and are set on sturdy chrome pedestals.

The tables team with Knightsbridge Calm stackable dining chairs in a matching laminate. Based upon a single-piece body, Calm upright seating displays a simple continual sweep from seat to back, thereby

ensuring easy-clean lines and graceful curves. For diners preferring to sit bar-style, the order also included Calm high stools, whilst the informal lounge area has been populated with Lynx sofas and armchairs, where sleek contemporary lines are enhanced by chromed metal legs and tailored vinyl upholstery. Neat low-level Geo stools complete the line-up

The order was awarded to Knightsbridge Furniture under SHS contract number TAG801.

The Golden Jubilee National Hospital opened in 2002 as part of the NHS National Waiting Times Centre and receives referrals from NHS Boards across Scotland. Specialising in procedures such as Orthopaedic joint replacements, diagnostic imaging, and Ophthalmology, the hospital is also home to the West of Scotland Heart and Lung Centre, a specialist unit that provides regional and national heart and lung services.
