

## Sunnyside House Care Home, Bangor



Over 250 chairs with complementary dining and coffee tables have been supplied by Yorkshire-based Knightsbridge Furniture to the Sunnyside House care home in Bangor, County Down.

A privately funded initiative run by the Presbyterian Residential Trust, Sunnyside House is a five-wing development for the care of the elderly which opened last October.
