

St Christopher's, London



A steady stream of seating and tables from the Knightsbridge Furniture Care portfolio has been delivered to St Christopher's Hospice in South-East London over the last 18 months or so as part of an ongoing programme of investment and the upgrading of furniture and fittings.

Founded by Dame Cicely Saunders in 1967, St Christopher's was the first hospice to link the control of pain and symptoms with care, education and clinical research, and is recognised internationally as a pioneer in the field of palliative medicine. From its Sydenham base, the hospice serves around 1.5 million people, catering for over 2,000 patients each year in a range of settings, including patients' own homes, four in-patient wards and its new Anniversary Centre.

Seating and tables from Knightsbridge Furniture continue to be specified for use throughout the hospice and already enhance the refurbished reception area, the Anniversary Centre lounge and the cafeteria, together with meeting and activity rooms, the Pilgrim room and the conservatory. Colours and shapes have been selected to reflect the pervading ambience of peace and serenity whilst meeting formal durability, easy-clean and low-maintenance requirements.

The Knightsbridge consignments for St Christopher's Hospice thus far have included high back chairs and sofas from the wraparound Melrose Club range, which contrast beautifully with the chic Charleston upright chairs and the sleek, contemporary lines of Lynx twin-seat settees. Kog lightweight and supportive foam cubes provide useful extra seating for children and young people, whilst the practical Malham and Polo tables and Cara stackable upright armchairs meet the need for versatile configurations and space maximisation within dining and activity areas.
