Knightsbridge Furniture Productions Ltd is committed to achieving Net Zero emissions by 2050.

Baseline Emissions Footprint

Baseline emissions are a record of the greenhouse gases that have been produced in the past and were produced prior to the introduction of any strategies to reduce emissions. Baseline emissions are the reference point against which emissions reduction can be measured.

Baseline Year: 2023 (Year 1.)	
Additional Details relating to the Baseline Emissions calculations. Our baseline emissions were established in June 2023 and certified by Planet Mark. The baseline year covers the 12-month period ending 30 June 2023. A 5% annual reduction target was set against this baseline. The 2023 baseline has been updated to include Scope 3 emissions from Employee Commuting, bringing the normalised total baseline to 909.9 tCO₂e (Scopes 1–3). This ensures consistency with the 2025 reporting methodology.

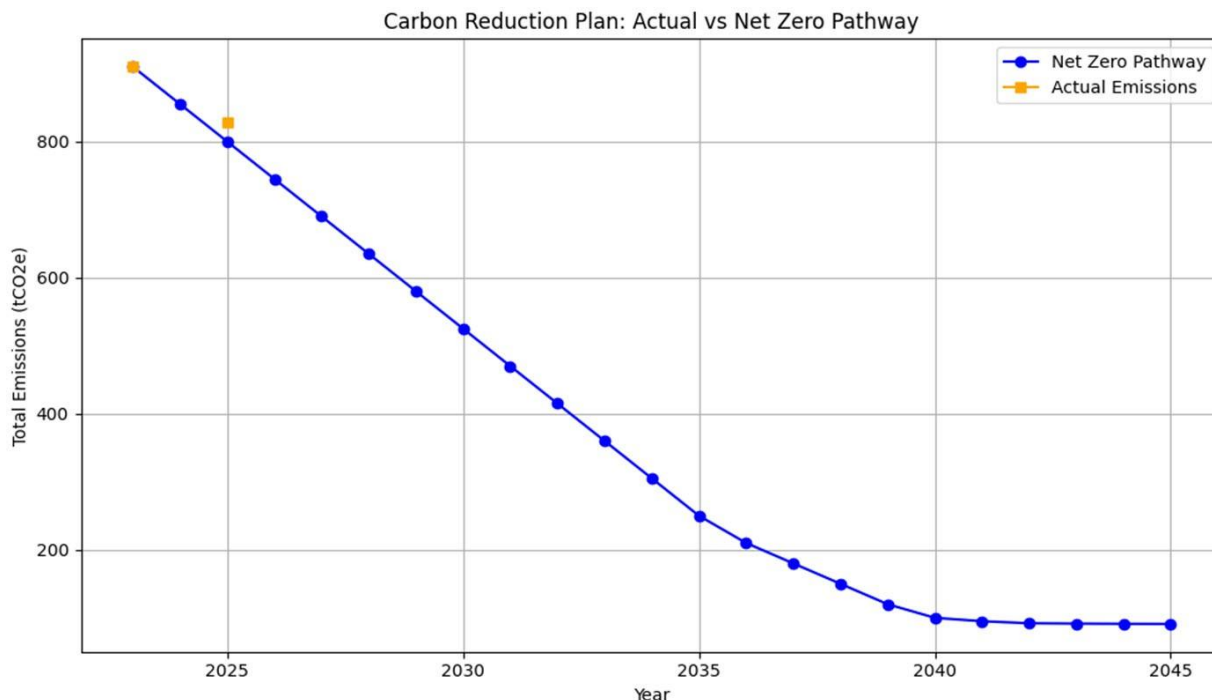
Emissions Reduction Targets

On a normalised basis, total emissions have decreased from 909.9 tCO₂e (2023 baseline) to 827.8 tCO₂e (2025). This represents a reduction of approximately 9% over the reporting period.

Future Emissions Reduction Targets

We have set the following targets to continue our progress towards Net Zero:

- Reduce total emissions by 20% by 2030 (from the 2023 normalised baseline).
- Achieve Net Zero before 2050, with our commitment made through the UN-backed Race to Zero campaign.



Carbon Reduction Projects

Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented since the 2023 baseline.

- Creation of a Carbon Reduction Team with the responsibility and authority to drive environmental improvement and coordinate all carbon reduction activity across the business.
- Company vehicle policy renewed to include all new vehicles to be either hybrid or full electric by 2025, with the aim to become fully electric by 2035.
- Installation of electric vehicle charging points within our premises.
- Installation of LED lighting and motion sensors within our premises.
- We have assessed the use of space within our building enabling the relocating and merging departments, resulting in energy savings and a reduction in carbon emissions.

Future Carbon Reduction Initiatives

- Continue the installation of LED lighting and motion sensors within our premises.
- As leases allow, convert the fleet of delivery vehicles to fully electric by 2035.
- Installation of Ecogate smart energy extraction system to optimise energy use by targeting specific areas as needed. Equipped with sensors, Ecogate activates dust collection only when necessary, significantly reducing energy consumption.
- Require suppliers and sub-contractors to commit to Net-Zero by 2050.
- Increase the use of cloud storage and decommissioning of local IT infrastructure.
- Enhancing our work with our supply chain to reduce their emissions (Scope 3).

Declaration and Sign Off

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 06/21 and associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans.

Emissions have been reported and recorded in accordance with the published reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans and the GHG Reporting Protocol corporate standard¹ and uses the appropriate [Government emission conversion factors for greenhouse gas company reporting](https://www.gov.uk/government/collections/government-conversion-factors-for-company-reporting)².

Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions have been reported in accordance with SECR requirements, and the required subset of Scope 3 emissions have been reported in accordance with the published reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans and the Corporate Value Chain (Scope 3) Standard³.
